It's a modern day treasure hunt! Search for World O! Water geocaches hidden around the Metro, learn more about water quality/quantity issues, and see examples of water related projects first-hand.

BACKGROUND INFO:

Geocaching is a fun activity that pairs nature with technology. Using a smartphone, search for small containers or 'caches' with goodies to trade out.

With over 250 parks in the Metro, it's a great way to explore our natural spaces! As a way to get your feet wet, four WO!W caches have been hidden around Omaha, focusing on water related projects and habitats. Follow the instructions below to get started!

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Smart-phone with QR Reader
- A free account on [Geocaching.com](https://www.geocaching.com)
- Re-usable water bottle (stay hydrated!)
- Sunscreen and bug spray is recommended

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Download the Geocaching app and create a free or premium account on [Geocaching.com](https://www.geocaching.com).
2. Go to <https://coord.info/BMA2NW7> to find a list of WO!W caches to discover.
3. Follow the cache instructions to find the final cache with freebies inside.
NOTE: Please only take a few items to ensure there is enough for everyone!
4. Solve a water related question located on the lid of each cache and enter the answers using this Google Form link - <https://bit.ly/2Uzk0jk> to be entered into a drawing to win prizes!

NOTE: If you plan on visiting more than one cache, don't submit your answers until you have finished. The more you find, the better the odds!
